Sixth Sunday of Ordinary Time (C) February 13th, 2022 Jer 17:5-8 / Ps 1: 1-4, 6 / 1 Cor 15:12, 16-20 / Lk 6:17, 20-26

The Beatitudes of Jesus, makes us reflect: God's values are upside down. God favors those who are weak and disadvantages. In other words, Jesus is saying the unfortunate of this world, precisely because of their present condition of deprivation are capable of appreciating the good things He is bringing them. They are like hungry guests invited to a grad feast. However, those who have everything they want or think they have everything they want can hardly appreciate what Jesus is bringing them because they don't feel the need of it.

When we talk about poverty, about being poor, what comes to mind is material poverty, But there is a worse form of poverty than that. It is to be lonely, empty and unloved. It is possible to be materially well-off but they can be more miserable than those who are materially less fortunate.

In the Sermon on the Mount, Christ proclaims the beatitudes of the kingdom which are diametrically opposed to the worldly standards. "Blest are you poor and blest are you who hunger," declares Jesus in our Gospel. On the other hand, Jesus says, "But woe to you rich for your consolation is now, woe to you who are full, for you shall go hungry." Christ undeniably is a sign of contradiction because what he is proclaiming is different from earthly wisdom. As St. Paul tells us, "The wisdom of this world is foolishness in the eyes of God" (1 Cor. 3:19).

The one thing which shuts a man off from God is self-sufficiency. Love's greatest glory is to be needed. But a person who puts his trust and security on his possessions will not feel a clamant need for God. He is self-satisfied. He is not open to love of God, to the need of forgiveness, to the necessity of obeying God's will, and to the life beyond this world. But no matter how wealthy he is, his heart remains empty because the core of every human heart is the need for God.


But when a man begins to realize that things mean nothing and that God is everything, he will put his whole trust in God. He will be conscious of his own helplessness and be able to detach himself from the

temporal value of things. He will attach himself to God, as he learns that only God can bring real happiness and security in life.

If God is our hope, our joy is completely independent of the chances and the changes of life. The world can merely give fickle joys. A collapse of health, a loss of fortune, failures and disappointments can easily defeat its shaky securities. But the Christian joy in Christ can stand through pain, sorrow and loss. It is a joy which nothing in life or death can take away.

Even in the face of suffering and persecutions, a disciple of Christ will see such a moment not as a penalty, but as a glory. It is taken as an opportunity to show one's faithfulness to the Teacher, and to share in the rewards of heaven. "No one," Christ said, "will take your joy from you" (Jn 16:22).

In the poverty of our hearts, let us pray that God may give us the courage to place all our trust and hope in him, that we may follow him completely in our lives, and attain with him completely in our lives, and attain with him the happiness that lasts forever. Happy are we who hope in the Lord.



Joseph Ricotta, MD, MS, DFSVS, FACS is a nationally and internationally renowned expert and innovator in the field of Vascular and Endovascular Surgery. He was the first in the U.S. to perform Endovascular Robotic Surgery, the first in Florida to perform the TCAR (transcarotid artery revascularization) procedure and has performed over 200 procedures since, making Delray Medical Center a national TCAR Center of Excellence. He was also the first in Southeast U.S. to perform VenasealTM procedure for treatment of venous insufficiency In addition, he pioneered renowned limb-preservation and pulmonary embolism treatment programs in Palm Beach County and founded the Florida Atlantic University (FAU) Vascular Surgery Fellowship and is a professor of surgery at FAU School of Medicine where he is training future vascular surgeons. Dr. Ricotta has also authored more than 200 publications and delivered more than 350 lectures.

Saint of the Week

Saint Claude de la Colombiére's Story

This is a special day for the Jesuits, who claim today's saint as one of their own. It's also a special day for people who have a special devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus—a devotion Claude de la Colombière promoted along with his friend and spiritual companion, Saint Margaret Mary Alacoque. The emphasis on God's love for all was an antidote to the rigorous moralism of the Jansenists, who were popular at the time.


Claude showed remarkable preaching skills long before his ordination in 1675. Two months later, he was made superior of a small Jesuit residence in Burgundy. It was there he first encountered Margaret Mary Alacoque. For many years after he served as her confessor.

He was next sent to England to serve as confessor to the Duchess of York. He preached by both words and by the example of his holy life, converting a number of Protestants. Tensions arose against Catholics and Claude, rumored to be part of a plot against the king, was imprisoned. He was ultimately banished, but by then his health had been ruined.

He died in 1682. Pope John Paul II canonized Claude de la Colombière in 1992.

Reflection

As a fellow Jesuit and as a promoter of the devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus, Saint Claude must be very special to Pope Francis who has so beautifully emphasized the mercy of Jesus. The emphasis on God's love and mercy are characteristic of both men.
