Experience tells us that a bad beginning necessarily brings a bad ending. No wonder architects and engineers spend so much time drawing out plans and blueprints before building a structure. Companies spend a lot of resources making feasibility studies before embarking on a business project, We can add more similar examples, but they all teach us the principle: a bad beginning would lead to a bad ending.

The principle, however, cannot be said to be necessarily true in our own spiritual life. Who among us has not abused and offended the goodness of God? In the first letter of St. John he said: "To say that we have never sinned is to call God a liar and to show that his word is not in us" (Jn 1:10).

Jesus told a parable of a man who had a fig tree growing in his vineyard, and he came out looking for fruit on it after three years but did not find any. Instead of cutting it down immediately, the tree was given another chance, It would be cultivated and would be given fertilizer to make it bear fruit. If not, it shall be cut down.

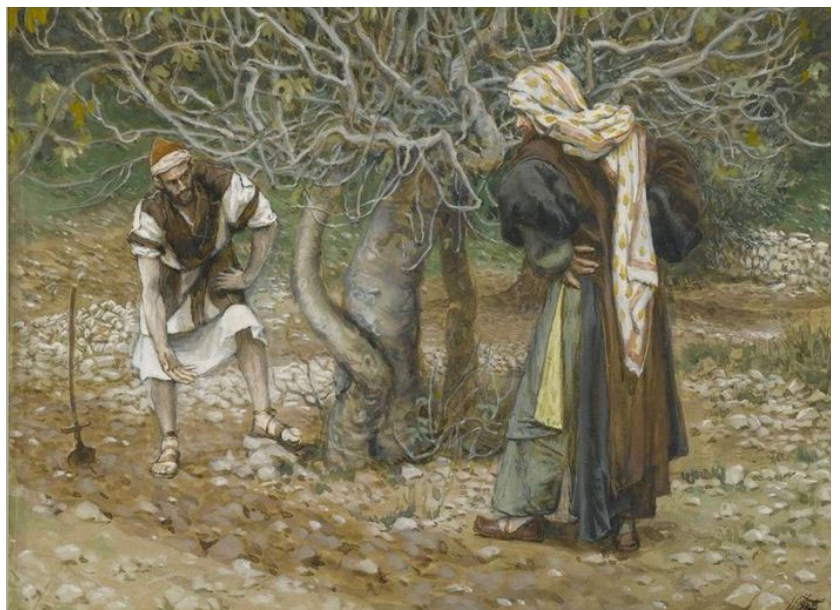
We represent the tree, God will looking out for fruit in us. With the blessings that we receive from him, what can we show him? Do we take out more than we put in this life, or do we try to put in more than we take out?

In any event, God is giving us a chance to prove our worth and usefulness. It's never too late to look into ourselves and respond to his call of conversion. Do not be afraid. Our responsorial psalm today reminds us: "The Lord is kind and merciful."

A bad beginning condemns one to a bad ending. It may be true with people. But not with God. In his love and mercy, a bad beginning leads to a good ending.

Forget our bad beginnings. We all love happy endings, don't we? It happens to many people. Let it happen to us.

### What is the Church's official position concerning penance and abstinence from meat during Lent?



In 1966 Pope Paul VI reorganized the Church's practice of public penance in his "Apostolic Constitution on Penance" (*Poenitemini*). The 1983 revision of the Code of Canon Law incorporated the changes made by Pope Paul. Not long after that, the U.S. bishops applied the canonical requirements to the practice of public penance in our country.

**To sum up those requirements, Catholics between the ages of 18 and 59 are obliged to fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. In addition, all Catholics 14 years old and older must abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday, Good Friday and all the Fridays of Lent.**

Fasting as explained by the U.S. bishops means partaking of only one full meal. Some food (not equaling another full meal) is permitted at breakfast and around midday or in the evening—depending on when a person chooses to eat the main or full meal.

Abstinence forbids the use of meat, but not of eggs, milk products or condiments made of animal fat.

### Exemptions from the Lenten Fast

Besides those outside the age limits, those of unsound mind, the sick, the frail, pregnant or nursing women according to need for meat or nourishment, manual laborers according to need, guests at a meal who cannot excuse themselves without giving great offense or causing enmity and other situations of moral or physical impossibility to observe the penitential discipline.

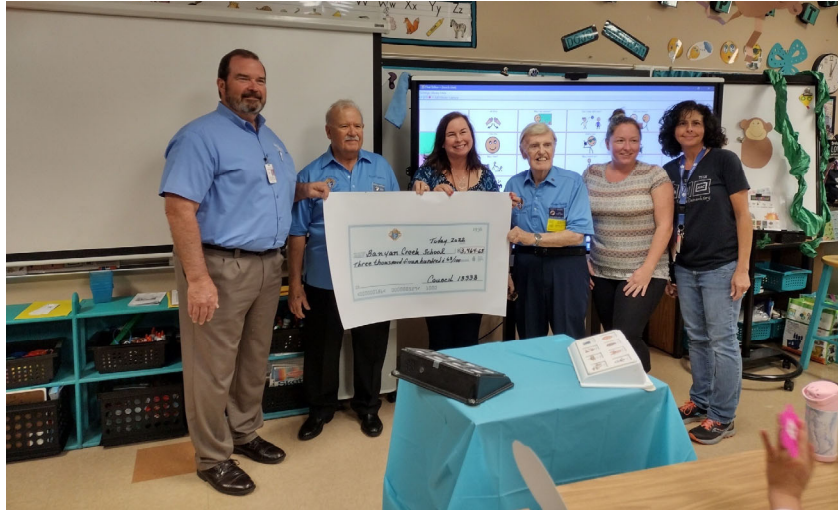

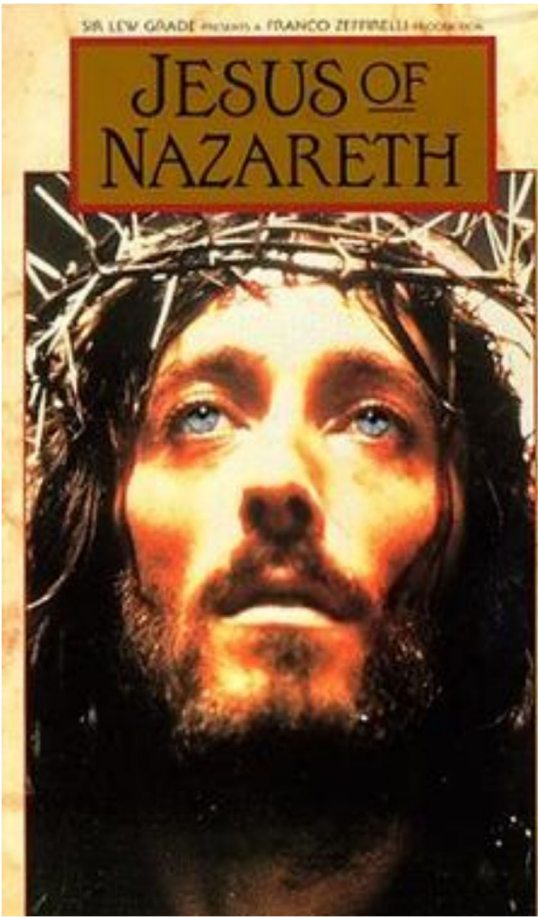
### Ladies Guild

## Saint Nicholas Owen's Story

Nicholas, familiarly known as “Little John,” was small in stature but big in the esteem of his fellow Jesuits. Born at Oxford, this humble artisan saved the lives of many priests and laypersons in England during the penal times (1559-1829), when a series of statutes punished Catholics for the practice of their faith. Over a period of about 20 years, Nicholas used his skills to build secret hiding places for priests throughout the country.

His work, which he did completely by himself as both architect and builder, was so good that time and time again priests in hiding were undetected by raiding parties. Nicholas was a genius at finding and creating places of safety: subterranean passages, small spaces between walls, impenetrable recesses.

At one point he was even able to mastermind the escape of two Jesuits from the Tower of London. Whenever Nicholas set out to design such hiding places, he began by receiving the holy Eucharist, and he would turn to God in prayer throughout the long, dangerous construction process.

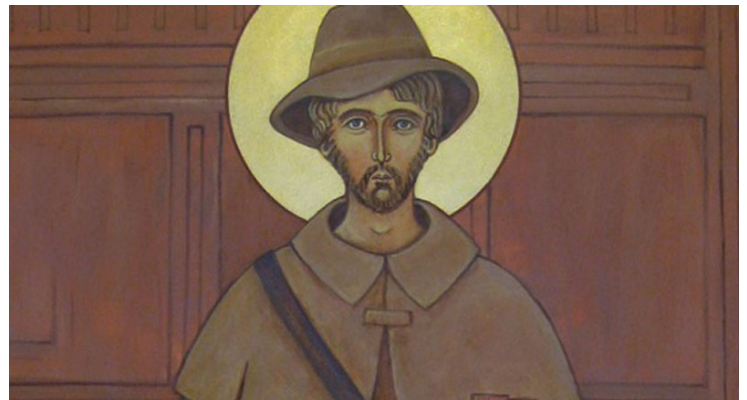
After many years at his unusual task, Nicholas entered the Society of Jesus and served as a lay brother, although—for very good reasons—his connection with the Jesuits was kept secret.

After a number of narrow escapes, he himself was finally caught in 1594. Despite protracted torture, Nicholas refused to disclose the names of other Catholics. After being released following the payment of a ransom, “Little John” went back to his work. He was arrested again in 1606. This time he was subjected to horrible tortures, suffering an agonizing death. The jailers tried suggesting that he had confessed and committed suicide, but his heroism and sufferings soon were widely known.

Nicholas Owen was canonized in 1970 as one of the 40 Martyrs of England and Wales.

### Reflection

Nicholas was a clever builder and architect who used his skills to protect endangered priests. Without his help, hundreds of English Catholics would have been deprived of the sacraments. His gift for spotting unlikely places to hide priests was impressive, but more impressive was his habit of seeking support for his work in prayer and the Eucharist. If we follow his example, we may also discover surprising ways to put our skills to God's service.

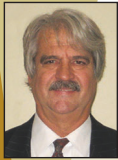
