

# THE ASCENCION OF THE LORD (C) May 29th, 2022 Act 1: 1-11 / Ps 47:2-3, 6-9 / Eph 1: 17 / Lk 24:46-53

Today we celebrate the solemnity of the Lord's Ascension into heaven. A story narrates that when Christ entered into his glory in heaven, the angel Gabriel was horrified to see the marks of the sufferings of our Lord. "Lord," he sadly asked, "do people know how much you love them? Do they appreciate what you did for them?"

"Oh no, not yet," Jesus replied. The angel Gabriel inquired, "Then what have you done to let them know about your love?" Our Lord gently responded, "I have asked Peter, Andrew, James, John and a few friends to tell others about me." But Gabriel, not satisfied, said, "What if Peter and the disciples grow weary? What if people after them forget? Do you have other plans?" Jesus replied, "I have not made any other plan. I'm counting on them.

Are the disciples better than us? They may not be in many respects. But why is it that the Lord worked on them? Why is it that they effectively preached the love and salvation of Christ to the world? It is because these were the people who dared. They thought, at first, that people like them should not preach. The Holy Spirit of the Lord gave them strength to get rid of their prejudice and fear. For this reason, they were emboldened to act as witnesses to the life, death and resurrection of Christ.

We, too, have our own prejudices and fears. People may consider Christianity as a private matter to discuss. It should not be publicly demonstrated. Professionals and employees should not proclaim the Gospel. Only priests should do that. And only in the church, not in the home nor in the places of work. People collaborating actively in the church are those who have nothing else to do. Busy people have no time to preach Christ. They have other things to attend to.

Do we preach the Good News of Jesus, or the good news only about ourselves and the bad news about others? Do we say only those things that people would like to hear? Do our fears prevent us to speak the truth?

We have received so much from the past. We are expected to do our part to contribute to the future. The Church is here to continue the mission of Christ, that is, to share the love of Jesus, to change the hearts of people.

Christ is with us now as we gather in his name. He promised he would be, and he gives himself to us in the Eucharist. He gives us a preview of our own future glory in his ascension and he has left us with the job of continuing his work, bringing the message of faith and the love of God to others.

As we face the beginning of the hurricane season, we pray that we will be blessed with no major storms in our area. We also pray in thanksgiving for the safety we have experienced in past seasons. As we continue to experience increased safety from the coronavirus pandemic and return to a more normal routine of life, especially within our churches, we also give thanks to God praying for continued safety while practicing prudent caution.

I again ask that we all join together in a united prayer effort in our parishes and schools to thank God for the past several relatively calm hurricane seasons and petition for protection from devastating storms in the upcoming seasons. We are so grateful to God for the narrow escapes we had in past years and continue to pray for all those adversely affected by storms of any kind, past and present. Our united prayer effort at the parish level can take three forms: Prayers of the Faithful, a short prayer for private and communal parish use, and weekly reminders in the parish bulletin with a prayer that families can pray at home. I also recommend using the *Mass to Avert Storms* in the Sacramentary at appropriate times during the season. For our schools and in student life I am encouraging prayer each day led by staff and a printed prayer that students can take home to their families for prayer at home.

## Blessed Angeline of Marsicano's Story

Blessed Angeline founded the first community of Franciscan women other than Poor Clares to receive papal approval.

Angeline was born to the Duke of Marsciano near Orvieto. She was 12 when her mother died. Three years later, the young woman made a vow of perpetual chastity. That same year, however, she yielded to her father's decision that she marry the Duke of Civitella. Her husband agreed to respect her previous vow.

When he died two years later, Angeline joined the Secular Franciscans and with several other women dedicated herself to caring for the sick, the poor, widows and orphans. When many other young women were attracted to Angeline's community, some people accused her of condemning the married vocation. Legend has it that when she came before the King of Naples to answer these charges, she had burning coals hidden in the folds of her cloak. When she proclaimed her innocence and showed the king that these coals had not harmed her, he dropped the case.

Angeline and her companions later went to Foligno, where her community of Third Order sisters received papal approval in 1397. She soon established 15 similar communities of women in other Italian cities.

Angeline died on July 14, 1435, and was beatified in 1825. Her liturgical feast is celebrated on July 13.

## Reflection

Priests, sisters and brothers cannot be signs of God's love for the human family if they belittle the vocation of marriage. Angeline respected marriage, but felt called to another way of living out the gospel. Her choice was life-giving in its own way.






