Sixteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time (C)
July 17th 2022
Gn 18:1-10a / Ps 15:2-5 / Col 1:24-28 / Lk 10: 38-42

Our Lord tells us in our Gospel today to spend moments of silence before God, listening to him like what Mary did. It is in those moments of silence before God that he can speak to us: it is where we can rediscover the value and meaning of our life and work; it is there where we can find strength and guidance from him. Yes, we need "a time to be silent" (QO. 3:7).

Many a person find this difficult to do. We can be like Martha who is so busy about many things. The modern-day man is not only confronted with air and water pollution, but even with noise pollution: noises that we get from the media of communication, the rage and fury of the machines that constantly haunt us, the hustle-bustle of the city life, and many more. This kind of pollution is not only detrimental to our health; it also deprives us of a conducive environment for prayer and listening to God.

Blaise Pascal once declared: "After observing man-kind over a long period of years, I came to the conclusion that one of man's great troubles is his inability to be still." But there is value in silence. Without it, words would soon lose their meaning, actions become empty gestures, and even prayers become distracted rituals. This might be the reason why God created us with two eyes and two ears but with only one tongue. He wants us to speak less, but see and hear more. God describes that we discern and listen always.

That Christ did not appreciate Martha's hospitality is not true. But he chided her for being so anxious and upset about many things. She forgot a very important element in her relationship with Jesus, that is, to allow time to listen to a friend, a beloved, and most of all, to her Lord and Teacher.

We too can be drawn to the danger of too much activity. We work and work as if there is no tomorrow. We may have sadly missed giving attention to enlivening our relationships with God, family and friends. We may think we are doing them a great favor by being workaholics. That maybe true, but not always. There are times that our presence and simply giving time to listen are the ones that matter most.

No man can live the Christian life unless he provides himself the time to be with God. How can we shoulder life's burdens unless we spend moments with him who is the Lord of life? How can we do God's work unless in God's strength? Not once, but many times in the Gospel, Christ did escape to a lonely place, away from the crowd, to pray to his Father even if he is busy with the work of salvation.

The challenge is to strike a balance between contemplation and action. One cannot do without the other. From the presence of God, we go to the presence of men, and we come out from the presence of men in order to seek the presence of God.

In this Mass, let there be a longing to seek the presence of God in the Word and the Eucharist. May we pray the words of Samuel,
"Speak Lord, your servant is listening" (1 Sam. 3:9).

Protection Against Hurricanes

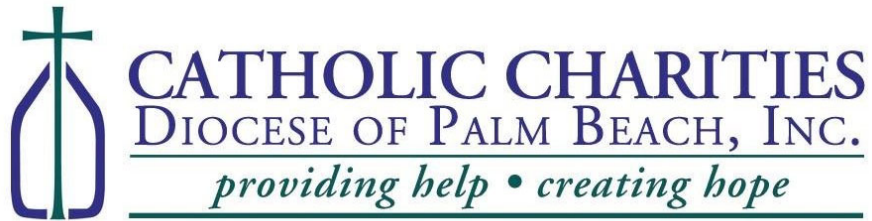

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

God's plan for human love and sexuality is good news and calls married couples to live with Christ-like love in sacramental marriage. While this call to authentic love is free, total, faithful and fruitful, the desire and need to manage human fertility remains part of the human experience. In response, the Church proposes Natural Family Planning (NFP) as a modern, scientific method available to couples for planning their families by enabling them to participate in God's creative action without breaking the inseparable link between the unitive and procreative meanings of the conjugal (marital) act. As NFP becomes a way of life, the couple cooperates with each other and God in responsibly planning their family without the devastating spiritual and physical harm caused by artificial contraceptive methods.

Each year, the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops (USCCB) sponsors a national educational campaign called Natural Family Planning Awareness week, to highlight the good news about God's perfect plan for human love and sexuality. This year, Natural Family Planning (NFP) Awareness week will be observed from July 24 through July 30 with the theme: *Called to the Joy of Love, Natural Family Planning, Supporting God's gifts of love and life in marriage.*

During this week, we also observe the anniversary of Pope Paul VI's papal encyclical *Humanae Vitae* (July 25) that articulates Catholic beliefs about human sexuality, conjugal love, and responsible parenthood. This week also marks the feast of Saints Joachim and Anne (July 26), the parents of the Blessed Mother and grandparents of her Son Jesus. Pope Francis has also designated that feast as World Grandparents' Day, a fitting commemoration during National NFP Awareness Week to highlight the importance of family and the wonderful blessing of children in our lives.

I would like to take this opportunity to congratulate those married couples who live out their marriage commitment to free, total, faithful and fruitful love. I encourage all married couples and those preparing for marriage to reflect on their current or future marriages and how they can authentically and responsibly fulfill their commitment to fruitful love. Saint Mary Magdalene's Story

Except for the mother of Jesus, few women are more honored in the Bible than Mary Magdalene. Yet she could well be the patron of the slandered, since there has been a persistent legend in the Church that she is the unnamed sinful woman who anointed the feet of Jesus in Luke 7:36-50.

Most Scripture scholars today point out that there is no scriptural basis for confusing the two women. Mary Magdalene, that is, “of Magdala,” was the one from whom Christ cast out “seven demons” (Luke 8:2)—an indication at the worst, of extreme demonic possession or possibly, severe illness.

Writing in the *New Catholic Commentary*, Father Wilfrid J. Harrington, O.P., says that “seven demons” “does not mean that Mary had lived an immoral life—a conclusion reached only by means of a mistaken identification with the anonymous woman of Luke 7:36.” In the *Jerome Biblical Commentary*, Father Edward Mally, S.J., agrees that she “is not...the same as the sinner of Luke 7:37, despite the later Western romantic tradition about her.”

Mary Magdalene was one of the many “who were assisting them [Jesus and the Twelve] out of their means.” She was one of those who stood by the cross of Jesus with his mother. And, of all the “official” witnesses who might have been chosen for the first awareness of the Resurrection, she was the one to whom that privilege was given. She is known as the “Apostle to the Apostles.”

Reflection

Mary Magdalene has been a victim of mistaken identity for almost 20 centuries. Yet she would no doubt insist that it makes no difference. We are all sinners in need of the saving power of God, whether our sins have been lurid or not. More importantly, we are all “unofficial” witnesses of the Resurrection.
