

The need to pray, however, is not only for saints. It is for all of us. If Jesus who is God himself and always in communion with the Father prayed, we who need prayer badly must take praying seriously.

The persistence of the friend in our Gospel reading gives us the encouragement to intensify our prayers. If the unwilling householder can be prevailed upon to supply the needs of his friend on account of his perseverance in asking, how much more will the loving God give to us what we need? "If you, with all your sins," Jesus said, "know how to give your children good things, how much will the heavenly Father give the Holy Spirit to those who ask him?" (Lk. 11:13).

Fyodor Dostoevsky, the famous Russian writer, declared: "Every time you pray, if your prayers are sincere, there will still be a new feeling and new meaning in it which will give you fresh courage and direction, and you will understand that prayer is an education."

We ask—an education of what? An education of dependence and trust in God as a child to his father. God is not only a creator and we are simply his creatures; he is not only a king and we are merely his subjects. If we enter into the discipleship of Christ, we can learn to perceive God as a Father and we as his children. We therefore immerse ourselves into an intimate relationship with God and with one another.

Gregory Baum in his book "Faith and Doctrine" wrote: "Believing that God is Father changes the way we experience life. We acquire a new awareness of ourselves and of our relationship to reality. To believe that God is Father initiates me into a new consciousness of my self as son. I have a destiny. This destiny makes me someone. I rejoice in myself."

"To believe that God is Father means to believe that men are destined to be brothers and sisters, and that salvation is at work in their history. God revealing himself as Father discloses a new self-awareness - I am son -A daughter a new experience of the world - 'we are a family.

Pray as a child. Pray like a child. Pray as brothers and sisters. Lord, teach us to pray as a family.


So many of you reached out to us, sharing your stories and your sadness – we thank you for your kind words and support. You were truly his family too.

Saint Joachim and Anne' Story

In the Scriptures, Matthew and Luke furnish a legal family history of Jesus, tracing ancestry to show that Jesus is the culmination of great promises. Not only is his mother's family neglected, we also know nothing factual about them except that they existed. Even the names "Joachim" and "Anne" come from a legendary source written more than a century after Jesus died.

The heroism and holiness of these people however, is inferred from the whole family atmosphere around Mary in the Scriptures. Whether we rely on the legends about Mary's childhood or make guesses from the information in the Bible, we see in her a fulfillment of many generations of prayerful persons, herself steeped in the religious traditions of her people.

The strong character of Mary in making decisions, her continuous practice of prayer, her devotion to the laws of her faith, her steadiness at moments of crisis, and her devotion to her relatives—all indicate a close-knit, loving family that looked forward to the next generation even while retaining the best of the past.

Joachim and Anne—whether these are their real names or not—represent that entire quiet series of generations who faithfully perform their duties, practice their faith, and establish an atmosphere for the coming of the Messiah, but remain obscure.

Reflection

This is the "feast of grandparents." It reminds grandparents of their responsibility to establish a tone for generations to come: They must make the traditions live and offer them as a promise to little children. But the feast has a message for the younger generation as well. It reminds the young that older people's greater perspective, depth of experience, and appreciation of life's profound rhythms are all part of a wisdom not to be taken lightly or ignored.






