GN 2:7-9; 3:1-7 | PS 51:3-6, 12-14,17 | ROM 5:12-19 OR ROM 5:12, 17-19 | MT 4:1-11

Temptations may lead us to sin. Spiritual writers tell us not to seek them for no one can be certain that they can be overcome. But they all agree that God does not tempt man, for God who is all good cannot lead man into evil. The devil can blind a man to accept an evil as a desirable good. We know that God allowed Satan to test Job to prove his virtue but it was not God who tempted him. It was Satan. Albeit, God does not will evil, but he allowed it by not preventing it. We can conclude that temptations may play a positive role in our life.

A product has to pass the test of quality before it goes out of the factory. A student has to pass a test, to hurdle a board examination before he is given a diploma. An applicant to a job has to pass a provisional stage before he is fully accepted as a regular employee. Temptations, likewise, act as a test of perfection in our Christian life. A temptation may be an indifferent act, a state of hesitation, which may result in sin when one yields to it. It fosters virtue when one can effectively conquer it. St. Peter cautions us: "Your faith will be tested like gold in a furnace" (1 Pet. 1:7).

The temptation of Jesus in the desert tells us that temptations induce us to sin. Sin is to say no to God and his ways. The adversary, had cunningly suggested to Jesus that he provide himself with more effective methods in carrying out his mission. The devil was trying to undermine his trust and obedience to his Father by proposing means that were easy. These were designed that Christ may avoid the cross and his death.

In Lent, let us spend time with the Lord, speak with Him, reflect on our priorities and confront our craving for the passing pleasures of the world. Let us allow God's mercy to wash away our sins.

The happiest people may not have the best, but they make the best of everything. Let us live simply, love generously, forgive until it hurts, speak kindly and live uprightly.

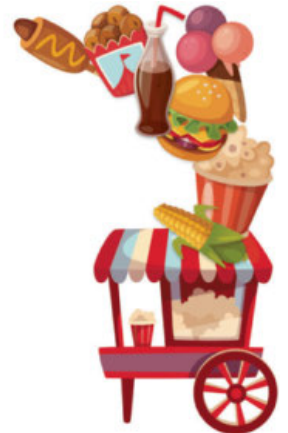

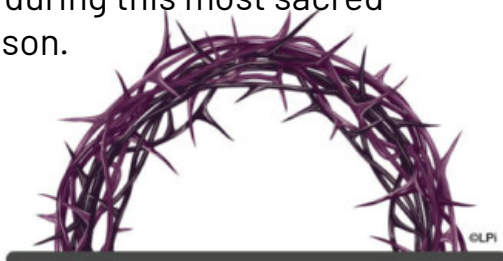




LADIES GUILD

SAINT CASIMIR'S STORY

FEAST DAY: MARCH 4

Casimir, born of kings and in line to be a king himself, was filled with exceptional values and learning by a great teacher, John Dlugosz. Even his critics could not say that his conscientious objection indicated softness. As a teenager, Casimir lived a highly disciplined, even severe life, sleeping on the ground, spending a great part of the night in prayer and dedicating himself to lifelong celibacy.

When nobles in Hungary became dissatisfied with their king, they prevailed upon Casimir's father, the king of Poland, to send his son to take over the country. Casimir obeyed his father, as many young men over the centuries have obeyed their governments. The army he was supposed to lead was clearly outnumbered by the "enemy"; some of his troops were deserting because they were not paid. At the advice of his officers, Casimir decided to return home.

His father was irked at the failure of his plans, and confined his 15-year-old son for three months. The lad made up his mind never again to become involved in the wars of his day, and no amount of persuasion could change his mind. He returned to prayer and study, maintaining his decision to remain celibate even under pressure to marry the emperor's daughter.

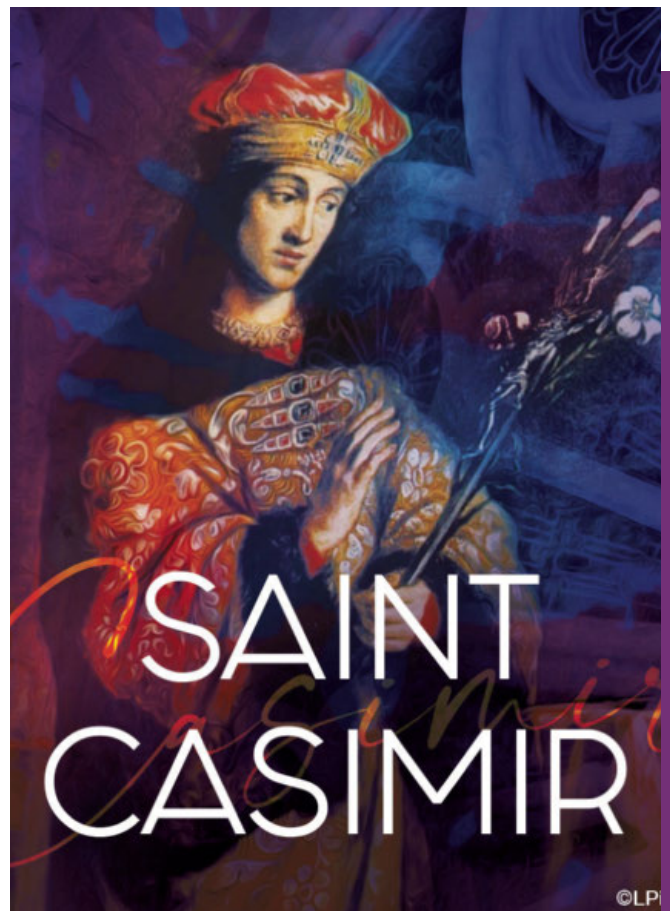
He reigned briefly as king of Poland during his father's absence. He died of lung trouble at 25 while visiting Lithuania, of which he was also Grand Duke. He was buried in Vilnius, Lithuania.

Reflection:

For many years, Poland and Lithuania faded into the gray prison on the other side of the Iron Curtain. Despite repression, the Poles and Lithuanians remained firm in the faith which has become synonymous with their name. Their youthful patron reminds us: Peace is not won by war; sometimes a comfortable peace is not even won by virtue, but Christ's peace can penetrate every government repression of religion.

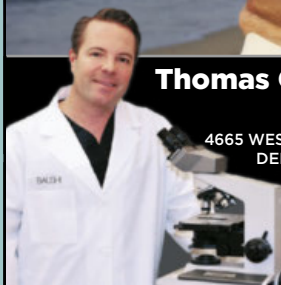

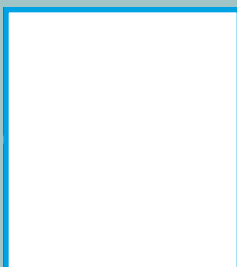
