ACTS 8:5-8, 14-17 | PS 66:1-7, 16, 20 | 1 PT 3:15-18 | JN 14:15-21

I remember the first time that I fell in love. I was 13 years old. I never told the girl that I liked her, I was too nervous and afraid that she might reject me. I can remember wanting to just look at her for as long as possible without her or anyone else noticing. I would often find myself imagining a meeting between the two of us in which both of us looked into each other's eyes for hours at a time. By this you can all tell that I am a bit of a romantic, and a sappy one at that. Just several years before, as a 10 or 11 year old boy, I would have wanted to throw up at the thought of gazing into the eyes of a girl. Love changes a person though and it is supposed to.

The reason I bring this up is not to expose the romantic musings of a 13 year old boy to all of you. Each of us has the moments we can go back to in our lives where we can remember the beauty of love. That first encounter with another person where you felt so alive that your heart would jump out of your chest. I want each of you to pause at this point and recall that moment... each of us felt so alive in that moment right! Did you know that that kind of love, which is so good and pure, is only a glimmer of the infinite love that God has for each of us?

Oftentimes we can say that God loves us, that he is a good God etc. but we rarely if ever experience the depths of that love for us. When we say that God loves us it is as personal and real as the love which beats in our own hearts. My invitation to each of us is to ask God to experience and know the depths of the love he has for us. To experience it and know as deeply as the 13 year old boy knew his first love.

It was this love that made Peter, James, John and Andrew leave their nets and their fathers to follow Jesus. What else but the infinite depths of love could have made them abandon everything they were familiar with to follow a perfect stranger? It is only love, the love of a God who loves us more intimately and deeply than our hearts could have ever hoped for. And it is this love that the Lord wants for each of us.

So, if you have never known this love, speak to the Lord today and ask him for this love. Ask him to know that you are loved by him. And if you have experienced this love before, ask the Lord for more love. His love is never failing.

The Voyage of Life is a series of four paintings created by the American artist Thomas Cole in 1840 and reproduced with minor alterations in 1842, representing an allegory of the four stages of human life. The paintings, Childhood, Youth, Manhood, and Old Age, depict a voyager who travels in a boat on a river through the mid-19th-century American wilderness. In each painting the voyager rides the boat on the River of Life accompanied by a guardian angel. The landscape, each reflecting one of the four seasons of the year, plays a major role in conveying the story. With each installment the boat's direction of travel is reversed from the previous picture. In childhood, the infant glides from a dark cave into a rich, green landscape. As a youth, the boy takes control of the boat and aims for a shining castle in the sky. In manhood, the adult relies on prayer and religious faith to sustain him through rough waters and a threatening landscape. Finally, the man becomes old and the angel guides him to heaven across the waters of eternity.



STORY OF SAINT BERNARDINE OF SIENA

FEAST DAY: MAY 20TH

Most of the saints suffer great personal opposition, even persecution. Bernardine, by contrast, seems more like a human dynamo who simply took on the needs of the world. He was the greatest preacher of his time, journeying across Italy, calming strife-torn cities, attacking the paganism he found rampant, attracting crowds of 30,000, following Saint Francis of Assisi's admonition to preach about "vice and virtue, punishment and glory." Compared with Saint Paul by the pope, Bernardine had a keen intuition of the needs of the time, along with solid holiness and boundless energy and joy. He accomplished all this despite having a very weak and hoarse voice, miraculously improved later because of his devotion to Marv.

When he was 20, the plague was at its height in his hometown of Siena. Sometimes as many as 20 people died in one day at the hospital. Bernardine offered to run the hospital and, with the help of other young men, nursed patients there for four months. He escaped the plague, but was so exhausted that a fever confined him for several months. He spent another year caring for a beloved aunt whose parents had died when he was a child, and at her death began to fast and pray to know God's will for him. At 22, he entered the Franciscan Order and was ordained two years later. For almost a dozen years he lived in solitude and prayer, but his gifts ultimately caused him to be sent to preach. He always traveled on foot, sometimes speaking for hours in one place, then doing the same in another town.

Especially known for his devotion to the Holy Name of Jesus, Bernardine devised a symbol—IHS, the first three letters of the name of Jesus in Greek—in Gothic letters on a blazing sun. This was to displace the superstitious symbols of the day, as well as the insignia of factions: for example, Guelphs and Ghibellines. The devotion spread, and the symbol began to appear in churches, homes and public buildings. Opposition arose from those who thought it a dangerous innovation. Three attempts were made to have the pope take action against him, but Bernardine's holiness, orthodoxy, and intelligence were evidence of his faithfulness.


General of the Friars of the Strict Observance, a branch of the Franciscan Order, Bernardine strongly emphasized scholarship and further study of theology and canon law. When he started there were 300 friars in the community; when he died there were 4,000. He returned to preaching the last two years of his life, dying while traveling.

Reflection

Another dynamic saint once said, "...I will not be a burden, for I want not what is yours, but you.... I will most gladly spend and be utterly spent for your sakes" (2 Corinthians 12:14). There is danger that we see only the whirlwind of activity in the Bernardines of faith—taking care of the sick, preaching, studying, administering, always driving—and forget the source of their energy. We should not say that Bernardine could have been a great contemplative if he had had the chance. He had the chance, every day, and he took it.


