



FALLING IN LOVE WITH JESUS

Most of you have probably seen images of the Sacred Heart of Jesus. Many of you may even have them in your home. But what is the Sacred Heart about? It may seem a little strange when you actually think about it. Someone's heart literally outside of their body for us all to see. The symbolism of it is quite profound. Have any of you ever had that experience when you've felt as though your heart was filled with so much love that I might burst out of your chest? That is what we see when we look at the image of the Sacred Heart. The love of Jesus is so profound and so deep that his heart is bursting with love for each of us.

The devotion as we celebrate it was popularized through the apparitions of Jesus to a nun St. Margaret Mary Alacoque in the 17th century. In these apparitions Jesus told St. Margaret Mary about his passionate love for every human person. The image of Jesus has his heart literally on fire showing us how his heart burns with passionate love for us.

I would like to pose a question to each of you. Do you know the burning and passionate love of Jesus for you in your life? Oftentimes it is easy to get into a rhythm in life. We do the things we need to do and forget about the deeper reason for our life. We just go through the motions as people say. The Sacred Heart of Jesus calls us out of that though. Although life has its rhythms and motions we are not supposed to be swept along by them. Rather it is the passionate love of Jesus which is supposed to sweep us along. Jesus calls us to be deeply and passionately in love with him just as he is in love with us.

It was love for you and for me that took Jesus to the cross to die. It was love that brought him to become incarnate in Mary's womb and become like us. He gave his whole self and he asks for nothing less in return. The passionate love of Jesus demands a response from each one of us. Will we choose to love him or not, to give everything for him as he did for us? Just as the love of a lover demands a response, so does Jesus love. We cannot remain indifferent to the same question that was asked of Peter "... do you love me?" (John 21:15-19).

To conclude, I present this prayer which is attributed to Father Pedro Arrupe: "Nothing is more practical than finding God, than falling in Love in a quite absolute, final way. What you are in Love with, what seizes your imagination, will affect everything. It will decide what will get you out of bed in the morning, what you do with your evenings, how you spend your weekends, what you read, whom you know, what breaks your heart, and what amazes you with joy and gratitude. Fall in Love, stay in Love, and it will decide everything."

So let us fall in love over and over again with Jesus who's Sacred Heart is inflamed for love of you and me.



VENERABLE MATT TALBOT

SAINT OF THE DAY FOR JUNE 18

Matt can be considered the patron of men and women struggling with alcoholism. He was born in Dublin, where his father worked on the docks and had a difficult time supporting his family. After a few years of schooling, Matt obtained work as a messenger for some liquor merchants; there he began to drink excessively. For 15 years—until he was almost 30—Matt was an active alcoholic.

One day he decided to take "the pledge" for three months, make a general confession and begin to attend daily Mass. There is evidence that Matt's first seven years after taking the pledge were especially difficult. Avoiding his former drinking places was hard. He began to pray as intensely as he used to drink. He also tried to pay back people from whom he had borrowed or stolen money while he was drinking.

Most of his life Matt worked as a builder's laborer. He joined the Secular Franciscan Order and began a life of strict penance; he abstained from meat nine months a year. Matt spent hours every night avidly reading Scripture and the lives of the saints. He prayed the rosary conscientiously. Though his job did not make him rich, Matt contributed generously to the missions.


After 1923, Matt's health failed, and he was forced to quit work. He died on his way to church on Trinity Sunday. Fifty years later, Pope Paul VI gave Matt Talbot the title venerable. His liturgical feast is celebrated on June 19.

Reflection

In looking at the life of Matt Talbot, we may easily focus on the later years when he had stopped drinking for some time and was leading a penitential life. Only alcoholic men and women who have stopped drinking can fully appreciate how difficult the earliest years of sobriety were for Matt.

He had to take one day at a time. So do the rest of us.


Do you have a deep love of Christ, the Church and your faith?
