### "FALLING IN LOVE WITH JESUS"

WIS 12:13, 16-19 | PS 86:5-6, 9-10, 15-16 | ROM 8:26-27 | MT 13:24-43

In the play *Romeo and Juliet* by William Shakespeare there is a famous line in which Juliet speaks to Romeo and says, "What's in a name? That which we call a rose/ By any other name would smell as sweet". What Juliet is saying is that she would still love Romeo, her lover, whether or not he was named Romeo.

This sentiment points to something true which is that there are names or conventions in our lives which are somewhat arbitrary. Her lover could have been named Peter or Dylan and she still would have loved him because of who he was. A name is about what something is, not about the name or title itself. At the same time the name Romeo, because of who it speaks of, fills Juliet with such love and affection since it points towards the person of Romeo. Juliet doesn't love the name Romeo though. She loves Romeo.

For us as Christians, this sentiment is quite applicable to our relationship with Jesus Christ. It doesn't matter what Jesus would have been called. It is the person of Jesus that we are called to be in love with. At the time that Jesus lived, Jesus was a very common name like Joe or John. But it wasn't about the name Jesus as such. It is about the person that the name Jesus points us toward.

Who is this person Jesus though? He is not an ordinary person, although he has a body and soul like you and me. He is God, the Lord of all things. This is the person that we are called to love and serve. Just as Juliet fell head over heels in love with Romeo not because of his name but because of who he was, so we are called to love Jesus because he is Lord and God.

Whenever we respond in love to God we must recognize that it is not because of anything that we have done but because he, Jesus, has loved us first. Our love is only a response to Jesus, the God-man, who loves us. We are each invited into this love of a

God who has come to love who we are. Juliet loved Romeo just for who he was and not for any other reason. Similarly, we are all invited to fall in love with Jesus for who he is, just as he has fallen in love with us for who we are.

Let us fall in love with who Jesus is. It is not because of convention or culture that we are Catholic Christians. It is because of Jesus and who he is.







## National Eucharistic Revival Supplement – July 2023

### BROTHERS AND SISTERS, OUR NATIONAL EUCHARISTIC REVIVAL IS NOW BEGINNING THE YEAR OF PARISH REVIVAL!

...And there is no better time to start it than in July, the month in our church calendar dedicated to the **Precious Blood of Jesus Christ**, the saving source of life that flowed from His Eucharistic heart on the Cross (John 19:34).

#### Back to Basics



The Catechism of the Catholic Church (CCC, 1339-1340) reminds us that the Eucharist is rooted in God's self-revelation to His chosen people. It is the **fulfillment of all the ancient symbols** of God's favor in the Old Testament:

- The **Manna** in the desert (Exodus 16)
- The showbread in the Temple, also called the **Bread of the Presence** in Exodus 25, and
- The Passover meal, with particular emphasis on the **Paschal Lamb** in Exodus 12.

#### The Fathers Know Best

The **Fathers of the Church** picked up on this connection very easily and drew amazing analogies between the Passover and the Eucharist. St. Jerome is just one good example of so many:



"After the symbol had been fulfilled by the Passover meal and He had eaten the flesh of the lamb with His Apostles, [Jesus] takes bread which strengthens the heart of man, and goes on to the true **Sacrament of the Passover**. Just as Melchisedech, the priest of the Most High God, in prefiguring Him, made bread and wine an offering, He too makes Himself manifest in the reality of His own Body and Blood." (~ *St. Jerome, Commentary on Matthew's Gospel*)

#### Liturgy and Truth



It is amazing how much solid theology of the Eucharist is contained in our Sunday liturgy, if only we have **hearts attentive** to the words of our Eucharistic Prayers!

"Be pleased to look upon these offerings with a serene and kindly countenance, as once you were pleased to accept the gifts of your servant Abel the just, the sacrifice of Abraham, our father in faith, and the offering of your high priest Melchizedek, a holy sacrifice, a spotless victim." (*From Eucharistic Prayer 1, the Roman Canon*)

## SAINTS JOACHIM AND ANNE

**FEAST DAY: JULY 26**

In the Scriptures, Matthew and Luke furnish a legal family history of Jesus, tracing ancestry to show that Jesus is the culmination of great promises. Not only is his mother's family neglected, we also know nothing factual about them except that they existed. Even the names "Joachim" and "Anne" come from a legendary source written more than a century after Jesus died.

The heroism and holiness of these people however, is inferred from the whole family atmosphere around Mary in the Scriptures. Whether we rely on the legends about Mary's childhood or make guesses from the information in the Bible, we see in her a fulfillment of many generations of prayerful persons, herself steeped in the religious traditions of her people.

The strong character of Mary in making decisions, her continuous practice of prayer, her devotion to the laws of her faith, her steadiness at moments of crisis, and her devotion to her relatives—all indicate a close-knit, loving family that looked forward to the next generation even while retaining the best of the past.

Joachim and Anne—whether these are their real names or not—represent that entire quiet series of generations who faithfully perform their duties, practice their faith, and establish an atmosphere for the coming of the Messiah, but remain obscure.

### Reflection

This is the "feast of grandparents." It reminds grandparents of their responsibility to establish a tone for generations to come: They must make the traditions live and offer them as a promise to little children. But the feast has a message for the younger generation as well. It reminds the young that older people's greater perspective, depth of experience, and appreciation of life's profound rhythms are all part of a wisdom not to be taken lightly or ignored.



Middle School and High School students the second and third Sunday of each month 10:30am-1:00pm



