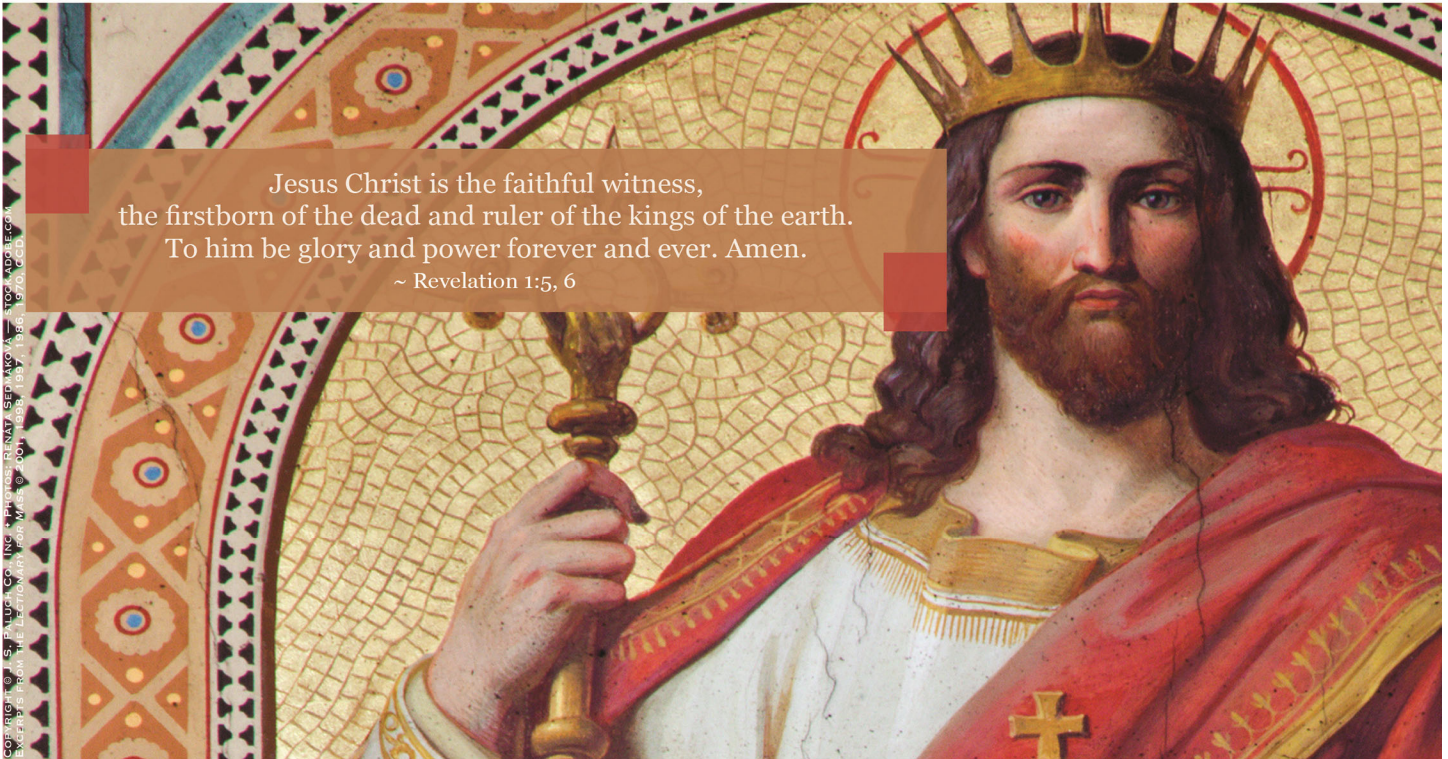

Thirty-fourth Sunday in Ordinary Time (B)
November 21st, 2021
Dn 7:13-14 / Ps 93: 1-2, 5 / Rv 1: 5-8 / Jn 18: 33b-37

Why do we still celebrate the feast of Christ the King when most of us today know kings only from fairytales and from history? And most kings in history were not good rulers. Even the Bible does not favor kings. For the kings would demand forced labor and taxes. And when the New Testament speaks about Jesus as king, it is when he is mocked and tortured.

A brief look at the beginning of the feast might answer our question. The feast was instituted in 1926 only, one year after a very successful Holy Year. Never before had so many pilgrims from all parts of the world come to Rome for a Holy Year. It had made visible the universality of the Kingdom of God: all nations united under Christ in the face of political divisions. It was a tune when emperors and kings were dethroned, when political instability threatened world peace. Pope Pius XI wanted all to realize that genuine peace and unity can be achieved only under the benign rule of Christ. Kings may lose their thrones - but one ruler who remains in spite of all political changes in the world. King of kings and Lord of lords.

Our times are not better. We feel anxious of what's going on in our country and in the world. We feel anxiety because of the economical situation. Where is the rock to which we can cling? The Church puts Christ as King before us. His kingdom is not built on worldly power but on humility and service, on the sacrifice of the King for his subjects. While millions have died throughout history for their kings, our King died for us! How different is our King from all other kings who were dressed in silk and gold, crowned with jewels. A look at our King, naked and wearing a crown of thorns, should wake us up from our life of pleasure, luxury and selfish endeavors. A look at our King who rules from a cross as his throne should wake us up and make us realize that, as subjects of this king, we are invited to follow his example by dying to ourselves. A look at our dying king who forgave in his agony his tormentors and a penitent criminal should wake us up and make us more compassionate and forgiving towards those who have wronged us. There is our King, the King of all kings, the Ruler of all the earth and of everything therein. There is our Christ! We own him homage and the best possible gift man can offer the King of creation. What would that be? Where can we find our King? What does he look like? How shall I recognize him? With all this questionings a poem by Rabindaranth Tagore entered my mind. Maybe it can help us find an answer to our questions:

"I had gone a-begging from door to door in the village path, when thy golden chariot appeared in the distance like a gorgeous dream and I wondered who was this King of all kings!

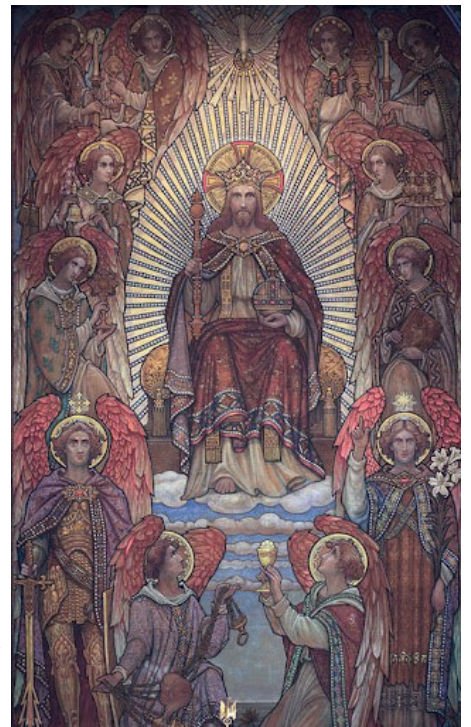
My hopes rose high and thought my evil days were at an end, and I stood waiting for alms to be given unasked and for wealth scattered on all sides in the dust.

The chariot stopped where I stood. Thy glance fell on me and thou camest down with a smile. I felt that the luck of my life had come at last. Then of a sudden thou didst hold out thy right hand and say `What hast thou to give to me?'

Ah, what a kingly jest was it to open thy palm to a beggar to beg! I was confused and stood undecided, and then from my wallet I slowly took out the least little grain of corn and gave it to thee.

But how great my surprise when at the day's end I emptied my bag on the floor to find a least little gram of gold among the poor help. I bitterly wept and wished that I had had the heart to give thee my all."

Our King will surely come to visit. In fact, he already did a number of times. But what he looks like we cannot know, for he is disguised like a common man or wealthy merchant. But one thing is sure through, when he comes, he will demand something from us: a service, a cry for help, a precious time, a food or drink, a shelter or comfort... keep your eyes open. He comes unannounced and unexpectedly. Be better prepared then; treat everyone who comes to you as your King. Hail to you, my King!

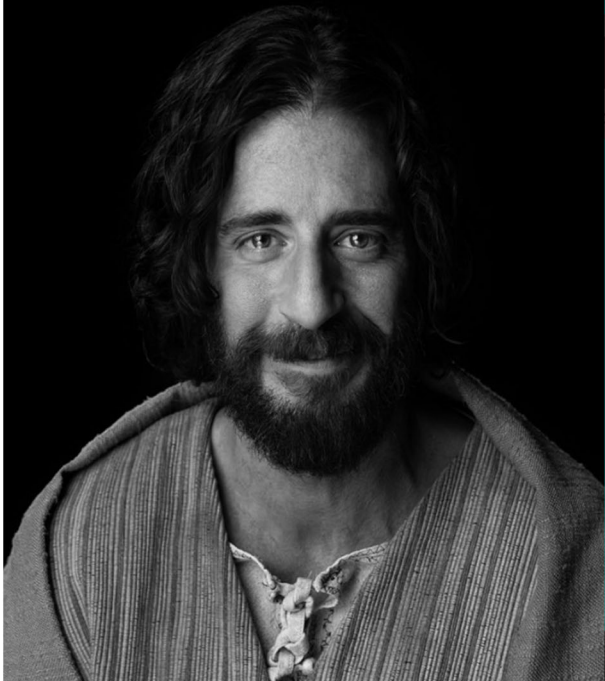

Saint of the Week

Blessed Miguel Agustín Pro's Story

Blessed Miguel Agustín Pro's Story

"¡Viva Cristo Rey!"—Long live Christ the King!—were the last words Pro uttered before he was executed for being a Catholic priest and serving his flock.

Born into a prosperous, devout family in Guadalupe de Zacatecas, Mexico, Miguel entered the Jesuits in 1911, but three years later fled to Granada, Spain, because of religious persecution in Mexico. He was ordained in Belgium in 1925.

Father Pro immediately returned to Mexico, where he served a Church forced to go "underground." He celebrated the Eucharist clandestinely and ministered the other sacraments to small groups of Catholics.

He and his brother Roberto were arrested on trumped-up charges of attempting to assassinate Mexico's president. Roberto was spared, but Miguel was sentenced to face a firing squad on November 23, 1927. His funeral became a public demonstration of faith. Miguel Pro was beatified in 1988.

Reflection

When Fr. Miguel Pro was executed in 1927, no one could have predicted that 52 years later the bishop of Rome would visit Mexico, be welcomed by its president, and celebrate open-air Masses before thousands of people. Pope John Paul II made additional trips to Mexico in 1990, 1993, 1999, and 2002. Those who outlawed the Catholic Church in Mexico did not count on the deeply rooted faith of its people, and the willingness of many of them, like Miguel Pro, to die as martyrs.
